- From a 500-schools pilot in 2007, Educate Girls has metamorphosed into a 24,000+ schools, over 18,000 villages across more than 33 districts in the states Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh & Bihar.
- Since inception, Educate Girls has enrolled 1.4+ million Out-of-school girls (OOSG); 1.9+ million children have benefitted from the remedial learning curriculum. Role Overview: The Government Engagement Lead will play a key role within the Project Management Unit (PMU) in the State. In this role, you will be responsible for:

- **Government Stakeholder Engagement**: Develop and maintain positive relationships with key stakeholders within the State Education Department, including officials, policymakers, and program managers.
- **Program Alignment:** Ensure alignment between the organization's program and the State's Open School Program objectives, collaborating with government counterparts to identify areas of synergy and opportunities for collaboration.
- **Strategic Planning:** Contribute to the development of strategic plans and initiatives within the PMU, incorporating government priorities and objectives into program design and implementation. Plan for Government Schemes convergence for open schools fee waiver.
- **Government Reporting:** Prepare regular reports and updates on program activities, achievements, and challenges for government stakeholders, ensuring transparency and accountability in program implementation.

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- **Capacity Building:** Provide training and capacity-building support to government staff and partners involved in program implementation, fostering a shared understanding of program goals and strategies.
- Monitoring and Evaluation: Collaborate with government counterparts to establish monitoring
 and evaluation mechanisms to track program progress and outcomes, facilitating data-driven
 decision-making.
- **Collaboration and Networking:** Represent the organization in government meetings, workshops, and other forums, fostering collaboration and networking opportunities with relevant stakeholders.
